
Improving National EVD and COVID-19 Preparedness and Surveillance Measures In Rwanda

Under the project "Improving National Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) and Coronavirus Diseases (COVID-19) Preparedness and Surveillance Measures in Rwanda" funded by the United Kingdom Department for International Development (DFID) through UNICEF, IOM Rwanda is strengthening health frontline workers' capacities. This is being done, amongst others, through the provision of incentives to Rwandan health professionals who are conducting EVD and COVID-19 screenings at Point of Entries bordering Democratic Republic of Congo, Republic of Burundi, Republic of Uganda and the United Republic of Tanzania. Active surveillance in the form of screenings¹ at the Point of Entries enables early detection of travelers with suspected symptoms and may limit the spread of diseases into the country.
